Braddock's Defeat In the battle at Fort Duquesne, about 900 Native Americans and Frenchmen defeated a British and American force of around 1,400 General Braddock indicated his surprise at the defeat as he died, asking: "Who would have thought it?" His final words were: "We shall better know how to deal with them another time"
