Blood pressure is usually measured in millimeters of mercury (mmHg) and is recorded as two numbers—systolic pressure (as the heart beats) “over” diastolic pressure (as the heart relaxes between beats)—for example, 130/80 mmHg Ask your doctor to write down for you your blood pressure numbers and your blood pressure goal level

Drip Pattern-- A bloodstain pattern which results from blood dripping into blood Expired Blood-- Blood that is blown out of the nose, mouth, or a wound as a result of air pressure and/or air flow which is the propelling force Flight Path-- The path of the blood drop, as it moves through space, from the impact site to the target
