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Law Of Attraction For Weight

Gravity: The Law of Attraction

- Gravity causes attraction between all objects in the universe
- The attraction increases with mass and decreases with distance
- Gravitational acceleration is independent of an object's mass
- Gravitational forces cause objects to orbit in circular motion (or ellipse)
- Objects moving too fast can escape orbit

Weight vs Mass Mass is the amount of matter It is a measure of inertia Weight of an object is a result of the Earth's attraction downward Weight is a downward force Example: An astronaut in space has the same mass as he does on earth while having different weights This ...

Chapter 5 NEWTON'S LAWS

The gravitational force will be equal to the body's weight (that's right, folks, when you step on a scale and it measures your weight, you are really measuring mg --the force of attraction between you and the earth). As weight is a force, its units in the MKS system are kilogrammeter/second², or newtons.

Chapter 4 Newton's Laws of Motion

By using the second law (described by Eq (410)) in 1D and converting the units (described by Eq (412)) we get $a = 20 \text{N} / 40 \text{kg} = 0.5 \text{m/s}^2$ (414). 44 Mass and Weight. Weight is a gravitational force acting on an object close to the surface of the Earth (to be precisely at the sea level) $w = mg$ (415).
