In Freud's analysis of Schreber's case, the patient's inability to achieve repression of his homosexuality results in his attempted transition into a transgendered individual Freud's hypothesis stated that Schreber's creation of a female identity was an attempt to legitimize his homosexuality to society (Schwarz 16) Likewise,
