The Crimean War was short by Napoleonic or 20th-century standards, but not by those of the 19th century, excepting the American Civil War which was atypically long The hostilities consumed only 31 months, dating from Russia's occupation of Turkish territory (July 1853) until the armistice (January 1856) It is not generally regarded as a "Great
