the Sumerians lived To solve this problem, Sumerians used mud from the river mixed with crushed reeds to make bricks. They baked the bricks in the sun, and then used them to build their homes and cities. The Sumerians were the first group of people to build cities in the world and their two most important cities were called Ur and Uruk.

SUMERIAN CULTURE

Sumerians were an ancient population that lived in the south of a region called Mesopotamia, located between the Tigris and Euphrates rivers (Mesopotamia means 'land between two rivers'). What was once Sumeria is now southern Iraq and Kuwait. HISTORY The Sumerians probably came from the area of Anatolia, and arrived in Mesopotamia about 3300 BC.

Sumerians knew they had to control the twin rivers The rivers flooded each spring When the waters went down, natural levees (lev' e`z), or raised areas of soil, remained behind The Sumerians built the levees even higher and used them to keep back the flood-waters During summer when the land became dry, they poked holes in the levees
