In 1922 Howard Carter, a British archaeologist, discovered the tomb of Tutankhamen Tutankhamen, also known as King Tut, was an ancient Egyptian king who died at the age of eighteen or nineteen Carter spent fifteen years searching for his tomb Carter thought that there must be undiscovered tombs in ancient Egypt's royal burial ground He

Nicknamed "The Gift of the Nile"

King Tutankhamen's Tomb The Boy Pharaoh King Tutankhamen was 9 years old when he was chosen to replace Akhenaton The priests of Egypt controlled King Tut, who died when he was only 19 years old His tomb was discovered in 1922 The tomb contained everything Tut would need in the afterlife We know about the Egyptian belief in the
