Young people's misuse statistics from NDTMS 7 Gender and age Two-thirds of the young people accessing specialist substance misuse services were male (66%) Around three-quarters (74%) were aged 15 or over The median age for both female and male was 15 years old Only 43% of females were aged 16 or over compared to nearly half (49%) of males

Interventions to reduce substance misuse among vulnerable ...

seem to affect substance misuse in young people in the USA A version of this intervention based around friendship groups may reduce overall cannabis and cocaine use However, if peer use of these drugs increases, the young person's drug use may be likely to increase too

Young carers of parents - The Children's Society

□ 40% of young people caring for a relative with drug or alcohol problems miss school or experience educational difficulties³ Children and young people in families affected by substance misuse can be very reluctant to let people know they are experiencing difficulties This can be due to the stigma surrounding their parents' drug or alcohol

Guidance on Good Practice for the provision of services ...

Substance misuse in children and young people presents a major public health challenge The UK has some of the highest rates of young people aged 15-16 using or misusing substances in Europe Currently there are rising trends in the use of alcohol (particularly by young women) and binge drinking has increased dramatically
